CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME'S RESPONSE TO WATERMASTER'S MOTION TO ADJUST FREE PRODUCTION ALLOWANCE FOR WATER YEAR 2011-2012; DECLARATION OF TROY KELLY IN SUPPORT THEREOF

I. INTRODUCTION

The California Department of Fish and Game (Department) files this response in support of the Mojave Water Agency's (Watermaster) motion to set the Free Production Allowance in the Baja Subarea (Baja) at 62.5% for 2011-2012 and to continue to reduce it 2.5% per year through 2014-2015. Although under the present circumstances the Judgment requires Watermaster to recommend a 5% reduction in the Free Production Allowance for Baja, the Court should grant Watermaster's motion for a continued 2.5% reduction because it is:

- Consistent with this Court’s 2010 order, which requires a 2.5% per year reduction through 2014-2015;
- Supported by all of the evidence submitted to Watermaster and to this Court; and
- Helpful in protecting the biological resources in Baja and Camp Cady Wildlife Area, which the Department manages.

II. BACKGROUND

The background of the Mojave Basin’s Physical Solution is set forth in detail in Watermaster’s Motion. (Motion, 3:1-4:20.) In summary, the original complaint in this matter was filed by the City of Barstow on May 30, 1990. On January 10, 1996, the Court entered a Judgment that addressed the overdraft situation in all five subareas and determined that the Mojave Basin Area (Basin) had been in a state of overdraft since at least the 1950’s. The Court approved a stipulated Judgment for each of the five subareas in the Basin. The Judgment established a limit on the amount of water each subarea could produce in one year without having to purchase replacement water, known as “Free Production Allowance.” The Judgment *requires* Watermaster to recommend a decrease in the Free Production Allowance for a subarea when that subarea’s Free Production Allowance exceeds its estimated Production Safe Yield by 5% or more. (Judgment, Exhibit H, H-1:27-H-2:13; see also Declaration of Troy Kelly in Support of the Department of Fish and Game’s Response to Watermaster’s Motion to Adjust Free Production Allowance for the 2011-2012 Water Year (Kelly Declaration), para. 7.)

In 2008, due to excessive water production, the Court set the Free Production Allowance for Baja at 70% of Base Annual Production, and ordered Baja to continue ramping down production. (September 10, 2008 Order at 2:7-12 [Granting Motion to Adjust Free Production Allowance For Water Year 2008-2009].) In 2009, the Court entered an order reducing the Baja Free Production Allowance from 70% to 67.5% of its Base Annual Production. (August 28, 2009 Order, at 2:3-5.) In 2010, the Department agreed to support Watermaster’s recommendation for a 2.5% reduction for 5 years in order to provide a predictable rate of rampdown for all parties and to avoid time-consuming and costly court preparations each year. Thus, the Court issued an order reducing the Free Production Allowance for Baja by 2.5% down to 65% for Water Year 2010-

1 2011 and also ordered the continued reduction of 2.5% per year for the next four years. (June 15,
2 2010 Order, at 2:8-12.)

3 In 2011, the Free Production Allowance in Baja again exceeds the Production Safe Yield –
4 this year by 35%. (Watermaster’s May 1, 2011 Annual Report, at p. 30.) Thus, Watermaster is
5 required to recommend a reduction from 65% to 60%. Additionally, as set forth in the
6 Watermaster’s Motion and the Watermaster Engineer’s declaration, the water levels in Baja are
7 continuing to decline at a rate of about two feet per year throughout Baja. As set forth in the
8 declaration of the Department’s Senior Environmental Scientist, Troy Kelly, that decline has had
9 a significant negative effect on the biological resources at the Department’s Camp Cady Wildlife
10 Area located in Baja. The Department supports Baja’s ultimate return to the provisions of the
11 Judgment as the operative management strategy in order to achieve safe yield in the shortest
12 amount of time yet, in support of a compromise reached in 2010, the Department today supports
13 Watermaster’s recommendation for the continued 2.5% rampdown for four more years.

14 **III. THE DEPARTMENT SUPPORTS WATERMASTER’S RECOMMENDATION**
15 **FOR A 2.5% REDUCTION IN THE FREE PRODUCTION ALLOWANCE FOR**
16 **2011-2012 IN THE BAJA SUBAREA.**

17 The Judgment requires Watermaster to recommend a 5% reduction in the Free Production
18 Allowance for Baja whenever the Free Production Allowance exceeds the estimated Production
19 Safe Yield by 5% or more. (Judgment, Exhibit H-2.) However, the Department supports
20 Watermaster’s recommendation for a continued 2.5% reduction because it is consistent with the
21 Court’s 2010 order, supported by all the evidence submitted to Watermaster and the Court, and
22 will help protect the biological resources in Baja and Camp Cady Wildlife Area, which the
23 Department manages.

24 **A. Continued 2.5% reduction is consistent with this Court’s 2010 Order, which**
25 **requires a 2.5% per year reduction through 2014-2015.**

26 In 2010 this Court issued an order reducing the Free Production Allowance for Baja by
27 2.5% down to 65% for Water Year 2010-2011 and also ordered the continued reduction of 2.5%
28 per year for the next four years. (June 15, 2010 Order at 2:8-12.) The Court’s 2010 Order
resulted from a compromise by the parties in order to provide a predictable rate of rampdown for

1 all parties and to avoid time-consuming and costly court preparations each year. (Kelly
2 Declaration, para. 6.) Because 2011-2012 is the second year of a five-year plan for 2.5%
3 rampdown, the Court should continue the 2.5% rampdown for Water Year 2011-2012 and for the
4 following three years through Water Year 2014-2015.

5 **B. All of the evidence submitted to Watermaster and to this Court support the**
6 **continued reduction in the Free Production Allowance for the Baja Subarea.**

7 All the evidence submitted to the Watermaster Board and to this Court concludes that an
8 additional rampdown in Baja is warranted. The Watermaster Engineer, Robert C. Wagner, stated
9 in his supporting declaration that: (1) while water production in Baja has declined about 35% in
10 the past three years, water levels continue to decline indicating continued overdraft; (2) even
11 though water production has declined, Baja producers could exercise carryover rights thereby
12 increasing production in future years; (3) pursuant to the Judgment additional rampdown in Baja
13 is warranted; and (4) the Free Production Allowance for Baja should be set at 62.5% and reduced
14 2.5% per year for the next 3 years. (Wagner Declaration, paras. 5-9.)

15 Watermaster originally proposed a recommendation that there should be no rampdown in
16 the Baja Subarea. (Wagner Declaration, para. 8.) This was apparently based on the fact that
17 water production in the Baja Subarea had declined by 20.3% in the past year. (Wagner
18 Declaration, para. 8.) The Baja Subarea Advisory Committee sent a letter to Watermaster
19 supporting the proposal for no rampdown because “verified production was 21,339 [acre-feet]
20 and so close to the production safe yield of 20,679 [acre-feet].” (Watermaster Motion, Exhibit C
21 [March 18, 2011 from Baja Sub-area Advisory Committee].) However, the issue is not whether
22 production is declining but whether the Free Production Allowance exceeds the estimated
23 Production Safe Yield by 5% or more. (Judgment, para. 24(o); see also Kelly Declaration, para.
24 7.)

25 On March 23, 2011, the Department submitted a letter to the Watermaster that set forth a
26 brief history of the Judgment, its requirements that the parties in Baja cut back their production
27 based upon the formula in the Judgment, the reduction imposed by the Court last year, as well as
28 the additional information provided to the Court and the Watermaster Board by the Watermaster

1 Engineer regarding water tables in Baja declining at least two feet per year for the last few years.
2 Because the goal of the parties subject to the Judgment is to achieve hydrologic balance in Baja,
3 the Department, through good faith effort and compromise, had accepted a lesser rampdown
4 percentage of 2.5% (proposed by Watermaster Engineer despite the continued overdraft in the
5 Baja subarea), even though the time frame for recovery of biological resources continues to be
6 extended. A copy of the March 23, 2011 letter is attached to the Declaration of Troy Kelly as
7 Exhibit 3. (Kelly Declaration, para. 5.) A representative of the Department also attended
8 Watermaster Board meetings, made presentations, and answered questions on March 23, 2011
9 and April 8, 2011. (Kelly Declaration, para. 3.)

10 **C. A continued 2.5% reduction will help protect the biological resources in the Baja**
11 **Subarea and Camp Cady Wildlife Area, which the Department manages.**

12 The Department has statutory and common law responsibilities to protect fish and wildlife
13 resources and habitats in the Baja Subarea, which are held in trust for the people of the State of
14 California by the Department. (Fish & G. Code, § 711.7.) The Department has jurisdiction over
15 the conservation, protection and management of fish, wildlife, native plants, and the habitats
16 necessary for biologically sustainable populations of those species. (Fish & G. Code, § 1802.) In
17 addition to these responsibilities, the Department owns land in the Alto and Baja Subareas, is a
18 member of the Baja Subarea Advisory Committee, and was a party to the litigation that led to the
19 Judgment. (Kelly Declaration, para. 1.)

20 Continuing rampdown is important because the decline in water levels in Baja has had a
21 significant negative effect on the biological resources at the Department's Camp Cady Wildlife
22 Area (Camp Cady) and on the Baja Subarea. (Kelly Declaration, para. 8.) Camp Cady consists
23 of 1,866 acres acquired between 1979 through 2001 for a total cost of \$2,046,481 in state bonds
24 for the public. Camp Cady had extensive surface water and riparian habitat when it was acquired.
25 The natural vegetation, especially riparian vegetation, in the Baja Subarea, is dependent on
26 groundwater. The roots of these groundwater dependent plants (called phreatophytes) must be
27 able to reach groundwater to survive. Declining groundwater levels have caused the death of
28 large stands of mesquite, cottonwoods, and willows (all phreatophytes) at Camp Cady and

1 throughout the Mojave River in the Baja Subarea. Notwithstanding, Camp Cady still contains
2 valuable riparian habitat. Riparian habitat is a rare habitat type in the desert. Desert riparian
3 habitat serves as critical bird breeding habitat, as well as important migratory stopover sites and
4 wintering areas for many bird species. One hundred six species of birds have been documented
5 using riparian habitat at Camp Cady (Patrick William Tennant; Impacts of Saltcedar on the Avian
6 Community of a Mojave Desert Wildlife Area May, 2002), including the state-listed endangered
7 willow flycatcher and state and federally-listed endangered least Bell's vireo (Draft Camp Cady
8 Wildlife Area Land Management Plan July 2005). At Camp Cady, habitat with a cottonwood and
9 willow canopy and a mesquite understory had the highest abundance of birds of all habitat types
10 at the Wildlife Area (Patrick William Tennant; Impacts of Saltcedar on the Avian Community of
11 a Mojave Desert Wildlife Area May, 2002). (Kelly Declaration, para. 8.)

12 Camp Cady was purchased for its surface water and associated riparian habitat values.
13 (Kelly Declaration, para. 9.) When running and pooled surface water was present, cottonwoods
14 and willows were abundant with a dense understory of honey mesquite. The Mojave River
15 historically surfaced in the center of Camp Cady and generally flowed from late October to
16 August. The months of September and October are generally the driest. These surface flows
17 have ceased in recent years as a result of the declining groundwater levels throughout the Mojave
18 Basin. At the time of its acquisition in 1979, Camp Cady contained an extensive mesquite bosque
19 of more than 500 acres, about 60 acres of cottonwood/willow forest, three groundwater-fed
20 riverbed ponds totaling six acres, and other locations within the riverbed with seasonal springs
21 and seeps. By 1997, primarily agricultural groundwater pumping and consumption of water had
22 caused a loss of more than 400 acres of mesquite, the riverbed ponds and seeps had been lost, and
23 remaining cottonwood willow was limited to mostly mature trees. By 2003 the
24 cottonwood/willow stands consisted of mostly mature trees with scattered patches of mesquite,
25 which were unhealthy with sparse leaves. Because the surrounding area continues to be
26 overdrafted without basin recharge, less water has been available to support riparian and aquatic
27 habitats. The cottonwood/willow forest at Camp Cady may persist and remain healthy when
28 water table depths do not exceed about seven feet and become highly stressed when depths

1 exceed 10 feet. Mesquites may not be able to survive a water table drop to below 15-20 feet
2 (Draft Camp Cady Wildlife Area Land Management Plan, July 2005). (Kelly Declaration, para.
3 9.)

4 The Baja Subarea is undergoing rapid environmental change due to groundwater
5 drawdown, causing the death of deep-rooted, native vegetation and the reactivation of wind-
6 blown sand (see Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Denyse Racine in support of the Department's
7 2010 response to the Watermaster's Motion - Department powerpoint presentation). (Kelly
8 Declaration, para. 10.) The loss of near-surface water has converted a vegetated area of the
9 1960's to a dry, migrating dune field now nearing Camp Cady and inundating vegetation and
10 buildings in its path (see Department powerpoint presentation). Deep-rooted, native vegetation
11 like mesquite once stabilized the sands of the Mojave River in the Baja Subarea. Groundwater
12 drawdown has caused the death of sand-stabilizing mesquite. Subsequently, other critical riparian
13 vegetation such as cottonwood and willows get scoured during large flood events and their
14 seedlings can no longer get established due to the lowered ground water table. New areas of river
15 are now open to wind erosion. Without competition from native vegetation, non-native saltcedar
16 (also known as tamarisk) becomes established and further draws down the water table. The
17 Department is now faced with the daunting task of trying to stabilize blowing sand, removing
18 non-native salt cedar, and restoring the severely degraded riparian system at Camp Cady. (Kelly
19 Declaration, para. 10.)

20 The Department continues to do what it can to decrease water use within the Mojave River
21 watershed and the Baja Subarea. (Kelly Declaration, para. 11.) Since 1996, when the Mojave
22 River Judgment was entered by the Court, the Department has removed approximately 30-40
23 acres of tamarisk (a non-native phreatophyte that consumes large quantities of water) at Camp
24 Cady. In addition, the Department used \$50,000 from the Biological Trust Fund (Trust Fund),
25 which it combined with \$46,000 of the Department's funds, to contract with the National Park
26 Service for the removal of an additional 50-60 acres of tamarisk at Camp Cady. That work was
27 completed in February, 2011. The Department also used \$500,000 (\$250,000 for fiscal year
28 2007-2008 and \$250,000 for 2008-2009) of the Trust Fund to support the Mojave Desert

1 Resource Conservation District's (RCD) "Tamarisk/Arundo/Russian Olive Eradication Plan
2 (Eradication Plan)" in the Mojave River watershed. The Department subsequently used \$100,000
3 of the Trust Fund to fund the Eradication Plan for fiscal year 2009-2010. It is expected that
4 removal of non-native tamarisk will contribute to the recovery of native riparian habitat and
5 reduce the amount of water consumed by non-native vegetation. The Department also plans to
6 use \$50,000 approved from the Trust Fund to repair an agricultural well at Camp Cady to assist in
7 native revegetation efforts. (Kelly Declaration, para. 11.)

8 In addition, the Department purchased, without using money from the Trust Fund, the
9 Hilarides property on December 12, 2001 at a total cost of \$819,350. (Kelly Declaration, para.
10 12.) The Hilarides property is located in the Baja Subarea adjacent to Camp Cady. Prior to the
11 Department's purchase of the Hilarides property, the pivot well in the lowlands portion of that
12 property pumped approximately 900 acre-feet of water per year. Since the Department purchase
13 and management of the Hilarides property began, the pivot well has pumped approximately 122
14 acre-feet per year on average (ranging from 193 acre-feet/year to four acre-feet/year). The
15 Department's current use and management represents a reduction of nearly 90% from historical
16 production. (Kelly Declaration, para. 12.)

17 Lastly, the Department applied for and received a matching grant of \$2.2 million on April
18 30, 2010 from the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to purchase private property and water
19 rights along the Mojave River to protect riparian habitat and threatened and endangered species.
20 (Kelly Declaration, para. 13.) The Department is awaiting release of non-federal matching bond
21 funds from the Wildlife Conservation Board and is seeking other non-federal partners to complete
22 this transaction. (Kelly Declaration, para. 13.)


1 **IV. CONCLUSION**
