## **Learn to save water this summer with Mojave Water Agency's free online class**

Apple Valley, CA — Mojave Water Agency (MWA) has opened registration for its upcoming Waterwise University workshop, Summer Irrigation, a free online class designed to help participants save water and energy during the warmer months.

The class will be held on April 15 at 6 p.m. and is open to anyone, both within MWA's 4,900-square-mile service area and beyond.

Led by local conservation expert Dakota Brooks, the workshop will provide practical, easy-to-understand strategies for improving outdoor water efficiency while maintaining healthy landscapes.

"This time of year is when outdoor water use really starts to climb," said Dakota Brooks. "With a few simple adjustments, people can save water, reduce energy use, and still keep their landscapes thriving through the summer."

During the course, participants will learn water-saving tips and benefits, how to protect landscapes during the summer season, how to monitor water meter use, and methods to conserve energy.

MWA's Waterwise University series is part of the agency's ongoing effort to provide education and resources that support water conservation and long-term sustainability throughout the region.
