## Mojave Water Agency begins community workshop series

Apple Valley, CA — Wondering where all that rainwater went after the recent storms drenched the High Desert? Principal Hydrogeologist Tony Winkel has the answers and will share them at Mojave Water Agency's first community event of the year.

Formerly known as the "ABCs of Water" the series has been updated as the "Wonders of Water" for 2023 and is scheduled for Tuesday, Jan. 31 from 5:30 to 7 p.m. in the boardroom at the Agency headquarters, 13846 Conference Center Drive in Apple Valley.
