



Policy Statement Clarifying the Mojave Water Agency's Relationship with the Cadiz Water Project and Related Projects or Initiatives

This Policy serves to articulate the Mojave Water Agency's current position regarding the Cadiz Water Project and related projects or initiatives¹. This Policy aims to prevent misinterpretations and ensure transparency regarding the Mojave Water Agency's involvement and/or interest in these projects or initiatives.

Any public or private statements suggesting the existence of any type of formal legal connection between the Mojave Water Agency, its Water Supply Contract with the State of California Department of Water Resources, its operational facilities (including the Mojave River Pipeline and Morongo Basin Pipeline), and the Cadiz Water Project and related projects or initiatives, are unauthorized and do not reflect the Mojave Water Agency's official position. The Mojave Water Agency does not have a relationship with Cadiz and is currently not a signatory to any agreements.
