1 **MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

2 I. **INTRODUCTION**

3 The Mojave Basin Area Adjudication Judgment (“Judgment”) contains a formula for the
4 proper calculation of Production Safe Yield (PSY) and Free Production Allowance (FPA). The
5 formula applies in each of the sub-basins governed by the Judgment, and this Court is asked to set
6 the FPA and PSY every year using the formula. Mojave Basin Area Watermaster
7 (“Watermaster”), in its Motion for Approval of Production Safe Yield and Free Production
8 Allowance (“Motion”) filed with this Court on July 6, 2026, acknowledges and then ignores the
9 results of the formula, as well as this Court’s recent order rejecting Watermaster’s proposed
10 revised base period of 2001-2020, and reinstating the 1931-1990 Base Period contained in the
11 Judgment. Instead, during a period where water levels in most of the Baja Subbasin are rising,
12 Watermaster appears to take a uniquely punitive stance with regard to Baja. It recommends that
13 the Court ignore its prior order rejecting Watermaster’s proposed base period and the formula in
14 the Judgment for setting FPA/PSY—and instead set the FPA and PSY in Baja at the same levels,
15 19.5%, as would pertain if the Court had approved Watermaster’s proposed 2001-2020 base
16 period.

17 Watermaster’s explanation for setting FPA in Baja at 19.5%, rather than the 24.5% ratio
18 that Watermaster’s Engineer concedes would otherwise pertain utilizing the 1931-1990 Base
19 Period, simply does not hold water, and it is inconsistent with the manner that Watermaster has
20 applied the formula for setting PSY and FPA in every other subbasin. Watermaster, asks this
21 Court to authorize increased production in the upper portions of the Mojave River Watershed
22 (thereby reducing surface flows to Baja even further), while claiming that the conditions at the
23 California Department of Fish and Wildlife (“CDFW”) facilities at Camp Cady, facilities which
24 have separate funding under the Judgment to pay for mitigation, require the five percent reduction
25 in Baja. However, it certainly seems that Watermaster is following the political winds rather than
26 the science in its motion since Baja is uniquely called out for reductions in pumping while
27 groundwater levels in Baja are primarily rising at the same time that the rest of the watershed,
28 other than Este, receives a recommended increased FPA allowance, an action that is likely to

1 reduce the surface flows needed to improve conditions at Camp Cady—if indeed Camp Cady is
2 genuinely of concern to Watermaster.¹

3 **II. FACTUAL BACKGROUND**

4 Newberry Springs Recreational Lakes Association (“NSRLA”) is an organization that has
5 for many decades managed a series of world class water ski lakes and facilities in and around
6 Newberry Springs. NSRLA’s pumping rights under the Judgment, rights that often result in their
7 pumped water returning to the Baja Subbasin through the unlined recreational lake bottoms, are
8 specifically called out and protected in the Judgment. (Judgment pp. 8, 16.) NSRLA relies on
9 pumped groundwater to keep its lakes at sufficient levels to allow year round waterskiing for its
10 residents and for visitors to the lakes that come from all across the United States and from other
11 countries. It has invested millions of dollars to do so—acquiring water rights from agricultural
12 operations even as ramp downs make continued operations more difficult every year, and while
13 pumping in Baja continues to drop every year.² NSRLA is an already cash strapped organization,
14 and each reduction in the FPA makes it more difficult for NSRLA to continue its nationally, and
15 internationally, renowned waterskiing operations in the Baja Basin.

16 NSRLA personnel have a good working relationship with CDFW—which has interests
17 along the entire stretch of the Mojave River—and NSRLA personnel often speak with CDFW
18 staff about the challenges they both face in Baja. One thing they generally agree upon—in
19 addition to the need for public review and improvements to Watermaster’s models so as to allow
20 them to better describe the relationship between discharge into Baja and upstream pumping and
21 diversions—is that *more surface water* is needed to support CDFW’s operations at Camp Cady,
22 which have not seen the same groundwater level recoveries observed in the more westerly and
23 southern portions of the Subbasin. (See Laton Decl. ¶¶ 17-20 and 21-24; Ex 3 [showing increases

25 ¹ As explained in greater detail herein, and in the Declaration of Dr. William Laton, enclosed
26 herewith, the reason that Camp Cady has not seen increased groundwater levels is because the
27 groundwater in the vicinity of Camp Cady is more reliant on Mojave River surface water flows
28 than other parts of the Baja Subbasin.

27 ² Motion at Ex. 3, p. 44 (declaration of Watermaster Engineer Robert Wagner [“Total pumping
28 in Baja has been declining since before entry of Judgment (1996), decreasing from approximately
50,000 acre-feet in 1996 to 10,481 acre-feet in Water Year 2024-25—a reduction of roughly 79%.
Since 2016, pumping has decreased by approximately 65%.”].)

1 in groundwater levels in wells west of and immediately to the east of the Calico Fault, but
2 showing essentially static or slight decreases in the shallow monitoring wells in and around Camp
3 Cady].). However, instead of recommending cutbacks in the upper watershed that might result in
4 more surface water reaching Camp Cady,³ the action most likely to demonstrate shallow
5 groundwater aquifer recovery needed to support the phreatophytes of concern to CDFW in Baja,
6 Laton Decl. ¶¶ 23-24, Watermaster in its motion instead recommends increased FPA and PSY in
7 Alto and Centro, the two subbasins where reduced pumping, or increased replenishment of
8 imported water, has the greatest potential to increase surface flows that reach Camp Cady,
9 particularly during wet years. (Laton Decl. ¶¶ 21-28, Ex. 3-5.)

10 While NSRLA is generally supportive of what CDFW is trying to accomplish at Camp
11 Cady (and other locations within the Mojave River), it also does not believe in empty gestures,
12 particularly where those empty gestures will cost NSRLA substantially more money to acquire
13 additional water rights to support existing operations, operations that are specifically described
14 and protected by the Judgment. (See Judgment at pp. 8, 16.) Accepting what Watermaster
15 proposes in the Motion is particularly problematic where doing so is not anticipated to provide any
16 meaningful benefit to CDFW facilities at Camp Cady, Laton Decl. ¶¶ 27, 28, and CDFW has
17 access to funding under Exhibit H of the Judgment (paid for by all of the other pumpers in the
18 Watershed) to fund additional irrigation to protect biological resources at Camp Cady.⁴

19 **III. UNDER THE FORMULA IN THE JUDGMENT, THE FPA SHOULD BE SET AT**
20 **24.5 PERCENT, NOT 19.5 PERCENT**

21 A. Watermaster Concedes that the Appropriate FPA Under the Judgment is 24.5%

22 The old adage that “no good deed goes unpunished” seems applicable to Watermaster’s
23 Motion, at least as it pertains to Baja. Pumping decreases dramatically, groundwater levels rise in
24 much of the Subbasin, and Watermaster recommends freezing the FPA at 19.5% anyway, which is
25 coincidentally the same number that pertained when Watermaster was improperly using a 2021-

27 ³ As demonstrated in the Laton Decl, the instances where the shallow groundwater levels at
28 Camp Cady rose were during years where there were substantial flows in the Mojave River, such
as 2005 and 2011.

1 2020 baseline without the Court’s authorization. As Watermaster’s Motion demonstrates, and as
2 corroborated by the Declaration of NSRLA’s expert William Laton, extraction of water in Baja
3 has decreased significantly since the Judgment was entered (Motion at Ex. 3, p. 44 [“(C)onsistent
4 with the substantial decline in pumping over the past 10 to 12 years—and the overall reduction
5 over the past 30 years—water levels in some wells are stabilizing, pointing to a reversal of the
6 long-time decline.”]). The results in recent years have largely been positive. During the last five
7 years, even without major replenishing surface flow events (the kind that are needed to replenish
8 locations such as Camp Cady—see Laton Decl. ¶¶ 21-28), groundwater levels in Baja are rising,
9 particularly in the portions of Baja Subbasin west of the Calico Fault, but also in some of the wells
10 east of the Calico Fault. (Laton Decl. ¶ 20, Ex 3.)

11 B. Watermaster’s Five Percent Downward Deviation from the “Indicated FPA” Is not
12 Lawful or Supported by the Evidence

13 Watermaster correctly calculates the “Indicated FPA” of 24.5% in Baja utilizing the 1931-
14 1990 Baseline, as corroborated by NSRLA’s expert, *see* Laton Decl. ¶¶ 7-16. But then politics
15 appears to enter the picture. Instead of recommending the 24.5% FPA that should pertain under
16 the 1931-1990 Base Period restored by the Court earlier this year, Watermaster developed an
17 excuse to keep the FPA for Baja at the same level as previously pertained under Watermaster’s
18 2001-2020 base period. Watermaster proposes an artificial reduction in pumping in Baja (FPA of
19 19.5% rather than 24.5%) without any legal or scientific basis for such deviation, as it seems
20 unlikely, given the characteristics of the Baja Subbasin, that the five percent decrease in pumping
21 proposed by Watermaster will impact the far shallower water table, immediately adjacent to the
22 Mojave River, at Camp Cady at all.⁵ Any impact related to pumping in most of Baja will not be
23 seen for decades because of the Calico Fault, which essentially cuts the Baja Basin into two
24 segments and intercepts groundwater flowing from the western to the eastern portion of the
25 subbasin. Perhaps more importantly, the 5% reduction in FPA recommended by Watermaster will
26 not benefit Camp Cady because the CDFW shallow aquifer at Camp Cady (which is between five

28 ⁵ As illustrated in Exhibit 3 to the Laton Declaration, most wells in Baja extract water between
100 and 200 feet below ground surface, while the Camp Cady wells show groundwater between 5
and 30 feet below ground surface. (Laton Decl ¶¶ 17-22, Ex. 3.)

1 and thirty feet below ground surface) is minimally impacted, if at all, by the pumping in the deeper
2 aquifer in other parts of the Baja Basin (between 100 and 200 feet below ground surface).

3 Vegetation at Camp Cady is adversely impacted by the lack of surface flow in the Mojave River,
4 not by deep aquifer pumping in other parts of the Subbasin. (Laton Decl. ¶¶ 27-28.)

5 Singling out Baja for special treatment under these circumstances is puzzling at best. Baja
6 is currently recommended for a 19.5% FPA while most other basins are over 40% FPA, and the
7 two Basins with the most potential to cause problems in Baja, Alto and Centro, are at 55% FPA.
8 (Motion at Ex. 4, p. 54, Table 1.) All of the basins other than Baja and Este receive an increase in
9 FPA under the approach Watermaster asks the Court to approve herein, and even Este, which
10 should have received an FPA of 33% under Watermaster's "Indicated FPA," receives a seven
11 percent increase by the Watermaster Board, at the same time that Baja receives a five percent
12 decrease, all at the same time that groundwater levels in Baja are improving in most of the
13 Subbasin (Motion at Ex. 4, p. 54, Table 1; Laton Decl. ¶¶ 20-22; Ex. 3.) It certainly seems as
14 though Watermaster is "following the politics" rather than "following the science" in proposing a
15 downward departure for Baja, in a manner that, to NSRLA's understanding, has not been formally
16 requested by CDFW.

17 In addition to arbitrarily reducing the FPA in Baja, the approach proposed by Watermaster
18 would also appear to conflict with the manner in which Production Safe Yield ("PSY") is
19 supposed to be calculated. Watermaster proposes to set the PSY based upon an FPA of 19.5%,
20 just as it did last year (while using a now disapproved base period). Thus, the PSY of 16, 211
21 should be approximately five percent higher absent Watermaster's decision to approve a five
22 percent downward deviation of five percent in the FPA. Watermaster's approach to calculating
23 PSY would appear to conflict with the plain language of Section II.A.4.aa of the Judgment, which
24 requires the PSY to be set at the "highest average annual amount of water that can be produced
25 from a Subarea," over a set base period (currently at 1930-1991), after considering current
26 demand, consumption and return flows, and, perhaps most importantly, "without resulting in a
27 long-term net reduction of groundwater in storage in the subareas." As previously admitted by
28 Mr. Wagner, groundwater pumping in Baja has dramatically decreased, and groundwater levels

1 have largely stabilized in Baja outside of Camp Cady—which as previously discussed herein is
2 much more impacted by lack of surface water flows in the Mojave River than pumping in the deep
3 aquifer. Moreover, as Dr. Laton explains in his declaration after evaluating groundwater level
4 trends throughout Baja as well as surface water trends and their anticipated impact at Camp Cady:

5 *“As previously discussed herein, the factor that most strongly controls Camp Cady’s*
6 *shallow groundwater and riparian habitat is episodic storm flow in the Mojave River,*
7 *which the FPA percentage in Baja does not regulate or effect. If anything, the*
8 *Watermaster’s current motion works against recovery of groundwater levels at Camp*
9 *Cady by authorizing increased production upstream via a higher FPA in Alto, which*
10 *further diminishes the storm flows downstream on which Camp Cady depends.*
11 *Accordingly, it is my opinion, to a reasonable degree of scientific certainty, that restoring*
12 *the Baja FPA to 24.5 percent as required by the Judgment formula under the 1931-1990*
13 *base period is not likely to adversely impact groundwater levels at the Camp Cady Wildlife*
14 *Area.*

15 Given the foregoing, Watermaster’s proposal appears to run afoul of Section II.A.4.aa of
16 the Judgment by recommending a lower amount of production, utilizing the 1931-1990 Base
17 Period, than could safely be pumped without causing any “long term net reduction in storage” in
18 the Baja Subbasin. Indeed, increasing the FPA to 24.5% as required by the formula in the
19 Judgment would not appear to cause any reduction of water in storage, and it would not appear
20 likely to cause any adverse impact to CDFW facilities at Camp Cady. If such long
21

22 **IV. Exhibit H Does not Require Disregarding the Formula for Setting PSY/FPA in Baja**

23 Not only is the approach taken by Watermaster in its Motion contrary to the formula in the
24 Judgment, and the requirements of the Judgment with regard to the setting of PSY, but the concept
25 floated as an excuse for the deviation—namely that Watermaster is required to refill the Basin at
26 Camp Cady (and apparently nowhere else) as mitigation for harm to river phreatophytes—has
27 been rejected by this Court.
28

1 Specifically, Judge Kaiser, in the Amended Statement of Decision in this case at Section
2 N, p. 21, determined the following:

3 *The Judgment Pursuant to Stipulation does not dedicate water in any specific amount to*
4 *the phreatophytes. The stipulated judgment will attempt to obtain the water table levels*
5 *that the California Department of Fish and Game set forth as being proper to sustain*
6 *those habitat areas, however, natural conditions such as fires and floods could affect the*
7 *extent of riparian habitat for the purposes of safe yield calculation.*

8 Judge Kaiser went on to state:

9 *Groundwater level standards have been established at certain points in riparian areas to*
10 *insure that water tables are maintained at sufficient levels to insure riparian growth. . .*
11 *There is however, in the stipulated judgment, a recognition that in some riparian areas,*
12 *there might need to be extraordinary efforts to protect the habitat, and the stipulated*
13 *judgment - provides a mechanism which-h is called a Biological Resources Trust Fund*
14 *which is funded- by assessments on all production and which is capped at one million*
15 *dollars in 1993 dollars. The fund can be used by Fish and Game to construct wells,*
16 *irrigate vegetation, do studies or other projects.*

17
18 A plain reading of Judge Kaiser's Statement of Decision indicates that there is no
19 obligation on Watermaster to reduce PSY and FPA in order to refill a subbasin to specific levels
20 that CDFW might prefer. CDFW is made whole by the Biological Resources Trust Fund
21 established in Exhibit H, paragraph 3, of the Judgment. Interestingly, Watermaster's Counsel
22 appears to agree with NSRLA's interpretation of Judge Kaiser's Statement of Decision with
23 regard to protection of phreatophytes in the setting of FPA and PSY.

24 At the June 24 Watermaster meeting, Mr. Lee McElhaney stated the following to the
25 Watermaster Board in response to CDFW's assertion that Exhibit H in the Judgment must be used
26 in determining FPA and PSY values. Mr. McElhaney stated the following:

27 *"There are two matters we are considering now, one is the FPA and the other is PSY.*

28 *There is nothing in the Judgement that states that protecting Public Trust Resources, are to*

1 *be considered when determining PSY values. Exhibit H however does provide the*
2 *consideration needs to be given to FPA values. Even as to the FPA values. the Judgment*
3 *does not indicate that it is a determining value. It's to be considered, but it's not the*
4 *necessary determining value, or factor to be considered. Instead, the courts decision by*
5 *Judge Kaiser, who was the original trial Judge in this case, made the following*
6 *observations, because I think they are instructive.*

7 *'Number 3, Groundwater level standards have been established at certain points in*
8 *riparian areas to insure riparian growth.'*

9 *Judge Kaiser went on to state, 'there is however in the stipulated judgement a recognition*
10 *that in some riparian areas, there might need to be extraordinary efforts to protect the*
11 *habitat. And the stipulated judgement provides a mechanism, which is called the biological*
12 *resources trust fund, which is funded by assessments on all production, and which is*
13 *capped at 1 million dollars in 1993 dollars. The fund can be used by Fish & Game to*
14 *construct wells, irrigate vegetation, do studies, or other projects.'*

15 *Finally, paragraph 3 of exhibit H of the Judgment, entitled 'Additional protection*
16 *pursuant to trust funds established by watermaster, using the proceeds of the biological*
17 *resource assessment' specifies the area in which the Biological Trust fund may be used:*

18 *'In the event that groundwater levels are not maintained, as set forth in Table H-2,' it*
19 *indicates that the funds may be used by F&W to 'purchase or lease supplemental water or*
20 *base annual production rights, to be used to meet riparian habitat water needs'.*

21 *Therefore, the Judgment does require that Watermaster give consideration for the*
22 *protection of public trust resources, but it does not mandate that that is the only factor to*
23 *be considered in determining your FPA recommendations. As I mentioned it does not*
24 *indicate it is to be considered in determining your PSY recommendations. That's the*
25 *clarification I wanted to add. Thank you very much.*

26 (Gaastra Declaration, ¶ 2 [quoting Mr. McElhaney's statement that he witnessed both in person
27 and by listening to a recording of the June 24 hearing].)

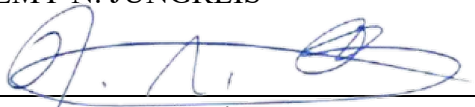
1 V. **CONCLUSION**

2 Watermaster acted outside of the Judgment in proposing to set FPA and PSY for Baja at
3 the same level that pertained prior to the Court invalidating watermaster's 2001-2020 base period.
4 As Watermaster's Engineer admitted in the Motion, the formula in the Judgment should have
5 yielded an FPA of 24.5% and a five percent higher PSY. Watermaster improperly deviated from
6 the required calculations allegedly to protect public trust resources, but as Mr. Laton's declaration,
7 and indeed, Mr. Wagner's own declaration, demonstrate, accepting Watermaster's
8 recommendation would do nothing to address CDFW's concerns at Camp Cady. They will only
9 make it look like they are doing something about the problem, a problem that is only solveable
10 with increased surface water flows in the Mojave River. Performative solutions are not real
11 solutions, and this Court should reject Watermaster's performative solution as reflected in
12 Watermaster's Motion. The Court should set the FPA at 24.5% as Watermaster concedes is the
13 proper calculation under the Judgment absent the "public trust" deviation that Watermaster
14 inexplicably and arbitrarily seeks to have this Court validate here.

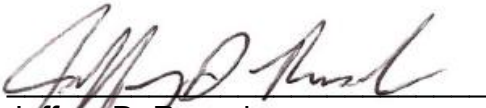
